Permits & Licenses

Just a reminder to please make sure you've obtained your <u>temporary restaurant license</u> if you need one. This will most likely pertain to those sampling or selling prepared food that is more than 3 oz., and/or needing cold or hot holding. Please see our previous vendor email for details about this, and don't hesitate to give Sombra Forest a call at the Multnomah County Health Department (503.988.7841) if you're unsure. Regardless of whether or not you need a license, all food handlers are expected to abide by the food safety rules that are required to obtain your <u>food handler's card</u>. Same goes for alcohol vendors--please be sure to obtain your <u>temporary sales license</u> well ahead of time if you need!

Posters & Postcards

Do you have a storefront or retail establishment, or participate in weekly farmers' markets? In the past many vendors have requested posters and postcards that they can hand out to their customers, or pass out in other ways around town.
